

Doubles Bocce League

Bocce is played with eight large balls (four balls to a team) and one small target ball. The object of the game is to get your balls closer to the target ball than your opponent by rolling, throwing, bouncing, or banking your ball. League play is on Tuesdays (Beginner) or Wednesday (Intermediate) evenings. League plays June 8—July 20 at Scenic Heights Park.



Teams interested in playing in the league must follow these procedures:

1. Pick up a registration form and packet at the Parks and Recreation Office beginning May 3.
2. Registration starts May 10. Registration fee of \$40 must be paid at the time of registering. (Team = 2 people)
3. Leagues will be filled on a first come first serve basis. Maximum of 10 teams per league.



All registered teams must attend the manager’s meeting. Information on meeting will be in the team confirmation packet.

Baggo League

Don’t get skunked! Join this new league! This league will play a 7 week regular season and then have a tournament. Teams consist of two players. Players take turns tossing twill beanbags at the holes of the target boards to score.
