

Picnic Shelter Rentals

A variety of facilities are located within the City's park and trail system and are available for use by the public. Facility use permits can be obtained for the exclusive use of a specific facility for a given date and time. Requests to reserve picnic shelters can be made by contacting Parks and Recreation at least seven days in advance of the proposed date(s) of usage.

Reservations will be accepted on a first come first serve basis at the Parks and Recreation Office. Rental fees must be paid with the reservation form. Call 233-9500 between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday to make your reservation. Picnic Reservation forms can be printed from the City's website at www.ci.shakopee.mn.us.

Special Use Permits are required for activities such as amplified or live music, pig roast, moonwalks, dunk tanks, weddings, car shows or events open to the public. There may be an additional charge for these events.

Rentals can be scheduled beginning January 2, 2010. Picnic Shelters are available for rental until September 30, 2010.

There is a \$50 deposit required for keys and rental equipment. Deposits are paid at the time of pick-up.

Youth Building Rentals

The Youth Building is also available for groups and private rentals. Located in Lions Park, the Youth Building is comfortable and quiet, suitable for all types of get-togethers. Reservation forms can be printed from the City's website at www.ci.shakopee.mn.us.

Rental rates are determined by length of use and residency. On weekday rentals there is a 2 hour minimum required. Sales Tax will be added to the rate listed below.

- Available to rent May 1 - October 16 (performance stage)
- Bookings for 2011 began on September 1, 2010 for residents and October 1 for non-residents.
- Rentals must conclude by 9:30 pm
- Certain tent, food and amusement use requires special permit (City and/or State) and proof of insurance.
- All rentals are final, regardless of weather conditions.
- Sales tax will be added to rental fee.

2010 Rates

Shakopee residents, businesses, churches and civic organizations: \$65 per hour w/2 hour minimum

Non-residents and Non-Resident Groups: \$85 per hour w/ 2 hour minimum

A \$100 refundable damage/cleanup deposit is also required.

There is a \$50 charge for chairs and sound system.

Shakopee Archery Park

The Shakopee Archery Park is located on County Road 101 just north of the Minnesota River.



This is a joint project with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, Minnesota River Valley Chapter of the Minnesota Deer Hunter's Association and the City of Shakopee.

The purpose of the Shakopee Archery Park and Range is to provide an archery facility that will provide shooting opportunities for local and regional use. The park is currently comprised of 10 shooting lanes with targets (field points only), as well as a designated broadhead shooting area (users must provide their own target).
