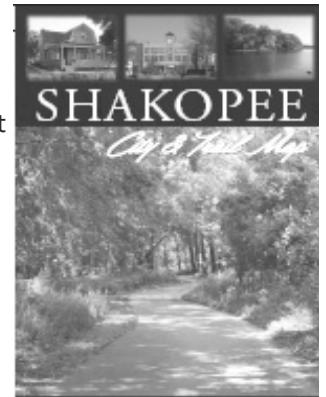

City and Trail Map Available

Don’t know how the trails connect? Pick up a copy of the current City and Trail Map. Use the new maps to assist you in navigating your way through the Shakopee park and trail system while experiencing all that Shakopee has to offer. The maps are available at the Shakopee City Hall, Shakopee Community Center and Chamber of Commerce.



The City will remove snow from park trails throughout the winter. Most trails will only be plowed during regular work days (Monday—Friday), but selected high use trails (as designated in the winter maintenance plan), will be plowed on the weekends. Trail plowing will begin on the first work day after a snow event of two inches or more or when drifting snow blocks pedestrian travel. Trails used by students to walk to school will be completed to allow pedestrian travel prior to school opening.

- Trails will be cleared in the following order:
1. Trails used by students to walk to school.
 2. Trails adjacent to streets.
 3. Interior park trails.

Trail plowing should be completed two working days after the street snow emergency, but maybe longer depending on the amount of snow fallen.

Picnic Shelter Rentals

A variety of facilities are located within the City's park and trail system and are available for use by the public. For exclusive use of a facility for a given date and time, a shelter reservation is required and can be made by contacting the Parks and Recreation Office at least seven days in advance of the proposed date(s) of usage. Reservations will be accepted on a first come first serve basis at the Parks and Recreation Office. Rental fees must be paid with the reservation form. Call 233-9500 between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday to make your reservation. Picnic Reservation forms can be printed from the City's website at www.ci.shakopee.mn.us.

Special Use Permits are required for activities such as amplified or live music, pig roast, moonwalks, dunk tanks, weddings, car shows or events open to the public. There may be an additional charge for these events.

2012 rentals will be accepted beginning January 3, 2012.

2012 Picnic Shelter Fee: \$65.00 (plus tax)

There is a \$50 deposit required for keys (Hiawatha, Scenic Heights, Holmes & Westminster) and rental equipment. Deposits are paid at the time of pick-up.

Youth Building Rentals

The Youth Building is also available for groups and private rentals. Located at 1103 Adams Street in Lions Park, the Youth Building is comfortable and quiet, suitable for all types of get-togethers. Reservation forms can be printed from the City's website at www.ci.shakopee.mn.us.

Rental rates are determined by length of use and residency. On weekday rentals there is a 2 hour minimum required. Sales Tax will be added to the rate listed below.
