### **Co-Rec Softball**

### Attention Softball Teams

Teams interested in playing in the 2010 adult softball leagues must follow these procedures:

1. Teams that played in the 2009 season must register their teams in the respected leagues between February 1 – February 19. Team Activity Fee of \$375 must be paid at the time of registration.
2. Any new team interested in playing in the 2010 league may register beginning March 3. Team Activity Fee of \$375 must be paid at the time of registration. Leagues will be filled on a first-come first serve basis.
3. All registered teams must attend the manager's meeting for the league they are registered for. Dates will be listed in the registration packet.
