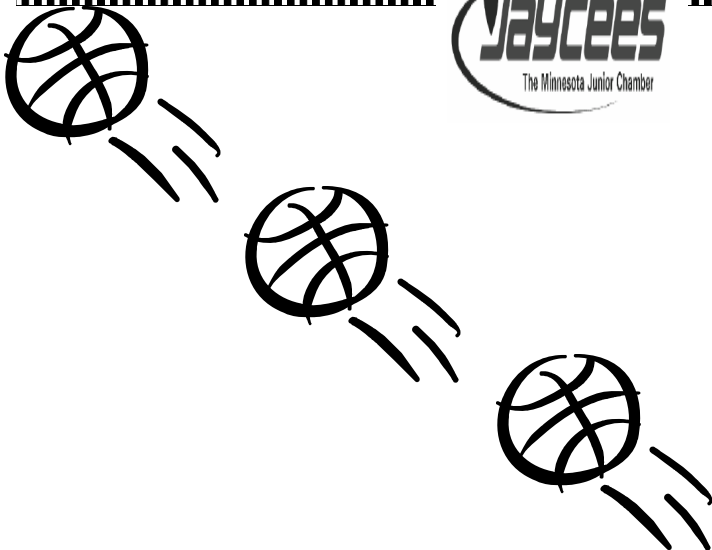

**USTA Junior Team Tennis**

This USTA sanctioned competitive program for players with match play experience. Players are divided by skill level and age and placed on teams of 8-10 players. USTA Jr. Team Tennis is the largest junior recreational tennis league in the country. This is the “Little League” for tennis. As the players grow into their skills, the format is adapted to best meet their needs. JTT is a combination of practice and match play with an emphasis on skill development, fun, teamwork and friendly competition. The local season consists of competing against other teams of similar age and ability level. Teams are made up of 1/2 boys and 1/2 girls and will compete against teams from the surrounding area. The team tennis season culminates with the Area Championships on July 19 & 20 in Shakopee. Winners will advance to the Sectional Championships at the U of M Baseline Tennis Center July 25 - 29. Sectional winners advance to Nationals in late October in Mobile, AL. All team players will receive 1/2 off entry into the Shakopee Summer Sizzler Championship on June 25-27 and 1/2 off entry into the Derby Days Dazzler tournament August 6-8. Practice starts on May 24th and match play begins the week of June 14. Teams are divided by age and ability.
