## June In Service Training Multi-Disciplinary Response to Domestic Violence

Staff attended Multi-Disciplinary Response to Domestic Violence training, presented by national trainer Mark Wynn, and hosted by Southern Valley Alliance for Battered Women at the Shakopee High School. Mark Wynn is a twenty year member of the Metropolitan (Nashville, Tennessee) Police Department, he also served as Lieutenant to the Domestic Violence Division, and is the recipient of the 1998 Nashvillian of the Year Award and the National Improvement of Justice Award.
